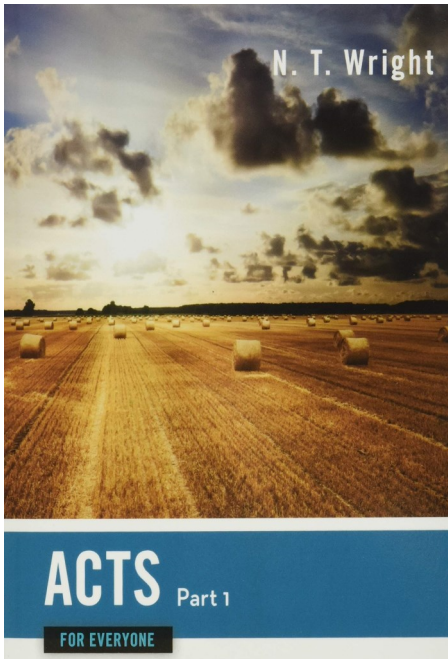
Continuing the Journey: Acts For Everyone Fall Reading Plan 2021
